FIVE THINGS TO SEEK IN PRAYER

1) SEEK GOD'S PRESENCE WITH A WORSHIPFUL HEART.

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name..." (Matthew 6:9)

2) SEEK GOD'S PRIORITIES OVER YOUR OWN.

**...your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
(Matthew 6:10)**

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (Matthew 6:33)

3) SEEK GOD'S PROVISION FOR YOUR DAILY NEEDS.

Give us today our daily bread... (Matthew 6:11)

And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:19)

4) SEEK GOD'S FORGIVENESS FOR YOUR SINS.

Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. (Matthew 7:12)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

5) SEEK GOD'S POWER TO OVERCOME TEMPTATION.

And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.' (Matthew 7: 13)
